DIY Flowers

We specialise in curating buckets of flowers and foliage for DIY wedding couples. It's a wonderful way to save on costs while making your day even more personal and unique. Our brides often turn their hen do into a creative flower arranging night, making their wedding bouquets and arrangements as a group.

How it Works

Let us know your chosen colours (brights, pastels, and any colours you definitely don't like!) and we curate a selection of flowers and foliage to help bring your DIY wedding vision to life.

Each bucket will contain a mix of flowers and foliages.

Small: £60 Large: £120

We suggest you collect your flowers 1-2 days before your special day. You will need your own buckets to take the flowers away with you, or you can buy these from us for £3 each. Delivery can be arranged at a fee.



DIY Flowers Bucket Options

Buckets for mixed decorations; Based on your colour scheme and what's in season, you'll receive flowers and mixed foliage perfect for a range of venue decorations, just let us know what you're planning to make i.e. urns, large vases etc.

Small: 40 stems Large: 95 stems

Buckets for bouquets; Featuring more of our show-stopping flowers for bridal and bridesmaid bouquets. Each large bucket will contain around 75-80 stems, enough to make your own bridal bouquet, or two bridesmaid's bouquets. Our small bucket is ideal if you're only wanting to make 1x bridal bouquet.

Small: 30 stems Large: 75 stems

Buckets for bud vases, buttonholes and corsages; Flowers and foliage perfectly formed for delicate buttonholes, jam-jars or bud vases.

Small: 50 stems Large: 96 stems

100% British Grown Flowers

At our Surrey flower farm, we grow over 100 varieties of beautiful and scented flowers and foliage so we can offer couples plenty of choice.

We're committed to growing flowers in an environmentally responsible way, without the use of chemical fertilisers, herbicides, or pesticides.

Our field-grown flowers are available from March to early October, and when we need to supplement our own blooms, we source only from trusted UK growers. **We never use imported flowers.**

Our most asked question is what flowers will we have on a certain month, however the flowers we grow and have access to vary throughout the year, influenced by the changing seasons and climate. We see this as an opportunity to create something truly unique and seasonal for your wedding day.

However, to give you an idea of what you can expect, we've gathered a selection of images showcasing the different blooms likely available at various times of the year.



Spring

March. April. May

As spring starts to emerge, the earliest blooms make their debut, signalling the season's arrival—narcissi, anemones, tulips, hyacinths, and ranunculus, all in soft pastels or vivid, cheerful hues. Spring blossom also joins in, bringing a light, airy, and romantic feel to floral arrangements.









Summer

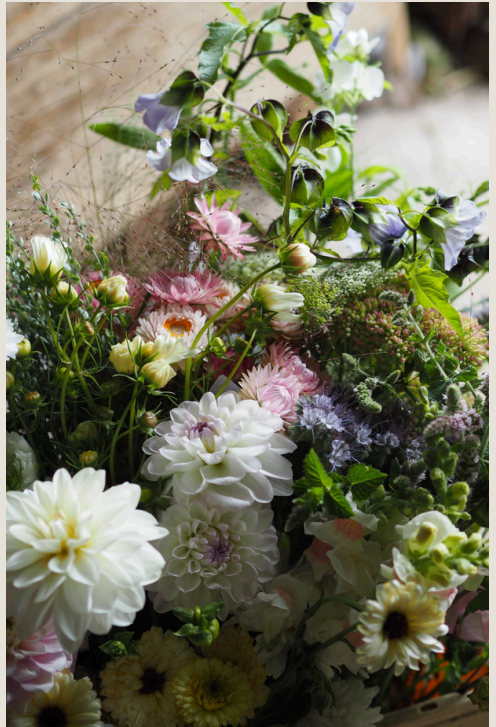
June. July. August

In the early days of summer, our field comes alive with the quintessential flowers of the English cottage garden—Cornflowers, daisies, nigella, and delicate ammi, along with peonies, roses, cosmos, snapdragons, zinnias and sweet peas. In late July and August, the focus shifts to bold dahlias in a huge array of colours and shapes.







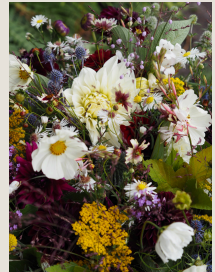




Autumn

September. October. November

Before the first frost, we're still blessed with a stunning selection of zinnias, snapdragons, rudbeckia, asters and dahlias. As the pace of the season slows, specialty chrysanthemums take center stage, adding their distinctive charm to our late-season blooms.









Winter

December. January. February

During the Winter months, we turn to other UK growers to source narcissi, anemones, hyacinths, chrysanthemums, and tulips. We pair these special flowers with beautiful berries, golden grasses and evergreen foliage. Our dried flowers also become very popular during the winter months, with the added bonus that you can keep all your flowers for years to come!

Please let us know your preferred date, colour choices, and the number of buckets you'd like. To secure your date, a £100 deposit is required. This amount will be deducted from your total balance, which is due approximately four weeks before you collect / we deliver the flowers.
